<b>Subject</b>	<b>OECD Announces Multilateral Convention to Implement Tax Treaty Related Measures to Prevent BEPS</b>



On 7 June 2017, over 70 Ministers and other high-level representatives participated in the signing ceremony of the **Multilateral Convention to Implement Tax Treaty Related Measures to Prevent Base Erosion and Profit Shifting** ("Multilateral Instrument" or "MLI").

Convention participants **have signed** or formally **expressed their intention to sign** an innovative multilateral convention that will swiftly implement a series of tax treaty measures to update the existing network of bilateral tax treaties and reduce opportunities for tax avoidance by multinational enterprises.

The new convention will also strengthen provisions to resolve treaty disputes, including through mandatory binding arbitration, thereby reducing double taxation and increasing tax certainty.
